DO YOU REMEMBER the advertisements for milk back in the 1990's that included the infamous tagline "Got Milk?" These ads, which sometimes featured a milk-mustache-wearing celebrity, typically showed some type of food, such as cookies or a peanut butter sandwich that might require a glass of milk to wash it down. Other companies quickly piggybacked on these ads, adding their own twist, such as "Got Ice?"

This simple ad came to mind recently when I was asked by someone, "Where is the hope when considering the lack of regard for preborn life in our culture?" This question made me step back for a minute and reflect. It's true that some days can be challenging, especially when we consider changes happening in the abortion industry which are making it incredibly simple to end a human life through a telehealth appointment and a couple of pills. Yes, some days reaching people to tell them what we offer at Real Options-which includes choices like parenting, adoption, and the truth about abortion-feels like an uphill battle. However, we always have hope because we have the Gospel. God's Word was true yesterday and will remain so for eternity. The Gospel is the balm that this hurting world so desperately needs. Our hope is that there is a Savior who created all life and loves each of us so much that He paid for our sins on the cross, making a way for us to have eternal life. This is the truth that will change how life is seen in our culture. This is what people need.


EXCITING UPDATE!

n recent months, we started advertising on social media in order to reach more clients to tell them who Real Options is and what we offer. What a blessing to be able to offer these clients a peek at life in the womb! NEW HAMPSHIRE NEWS

Recently, the Fetal Life Protection Act, which bans abortions after 24 weeks (except in cases where there is danger to the physical health or life of the mother), was enacted. This is New Hampshire's first ban on late-term abortions. Prior to this, abortion was legal up until birth, with the only restriction being on partial-birth abortion. New Hampshire is one of many states that has passed legislation in 2021 restricting abortion.



THE "ABORTION PILL," ALSO KNOWN AS RU-486, has been available in the United States since the year 2000. Since that time, it is estimated that 2.75 million women have used this drug to terminate their pregnancies. The drug combination was originally limited for use in pregnancies up to 7 weeks gestation; that time was increased to 10 weeks in 2016.

This medical or chemical abortion consists of two pills taken by the woman, typically in her home. The first pill, Mifiprex, blocks the hormone progesterone, which is necessary for a pregnancy to continue. Without progesterone, fetal death usually occurs within days in most cases. The second drug, Misoprostol, taken 24-48 hours after the first pill induces cramping which ultimately expels the fetus.

This abortion method, once prescribed and carried out with a medical evaluation and supervision, became something a woman could obtain (in many cases) without a doctor's visit or an ultrasound appointment during the pan-

demic. At the peak of the pandemic, healthcare moved online, which in many cases was appropriate and safe. In the case of obtaining RU-486, it was not, nor does it continue to be in the best interest of a mother or her developing baby.

RU-486 is often chosen because of the anonymity it provides. There is no appointment for a surgical procedure, and the woman decides when and where to start the procedure. It sounds easy and confidential. However, many of our clients who have taken this drug to terminate a pregnancy describe it as traumatic and say, "never again."

Some women take the first pill and experience immediate regret and panic. In this situation, there is hope, as well as the potential to reverse an initiated abortion. Our Real Options Medical Director, Dr. Nicole Varasteh, is registered nationally with Abortion Pill Reversal. This organization facilitates care for women who change their mind after starting a chemical abortion. Real Options is grateful to have an overseeing medical director who can offer support to a woman who changes her mind and chooses life.

Honoring a Dedicated Volunteer SHERI RADZELOVAGE

ON JUNE 30TH THE REAL OPTIONS MANCHESTER CENTER held a service to honor the life of Sheri Radzelovage. Sheri dedicated more than 20 years to Real Options, as she faithfully served in numerous ways, including the overseeing of our Manchester Boutique, a place where clients can have their material needs met in a tangible way.

Sheri, who once had a crisis pregnancy of her own, knew that the women who walk through our doors deserve to be treated with the utmost of dignity and respect. Her gift was in making sure that every item available in our Boutique was fresh and attractive. We can only imagine how many women felt cared for as they lovingly selected beautiful items for their soon-to-be-born babies. Sheri and her entire team made these moments possible because of their dedication to the ministry.

On March 31, 2021, Sheri went home to be with the Lord. We truly

When I initially set our walk goal, I just put in the minimum. As the donations came in, I kept needing to raise it. Finally I got on my knees and prayed, "God, what should I set it for?" I heard \$1200. At that point we were less than 24 hours from the walk, and we were at around \$750. I thought *maybe* we could get to \$1,000(!!) So I put in \$1200 as my online goal. In the evening, as I checked my computer, my eyes popped when I saw we were at \$1900!! My first thought was there must be a mistake, as my brain could not comprehend it! But we had received an anonymous donation for \$1000! And still, the donations came, even the next morning, even after we had walked.

In the end, God used our walk to raise over \$2400. He didn't want to just show us He is able, but that He is MORE THAN ABLE! I am in tears as I share this story. We will never forget



this walk or the spiritual encouragement it was to our hearts. We often refer back to it, and remember that God is MORE THAN ABLE to do all we ask or imagine.
